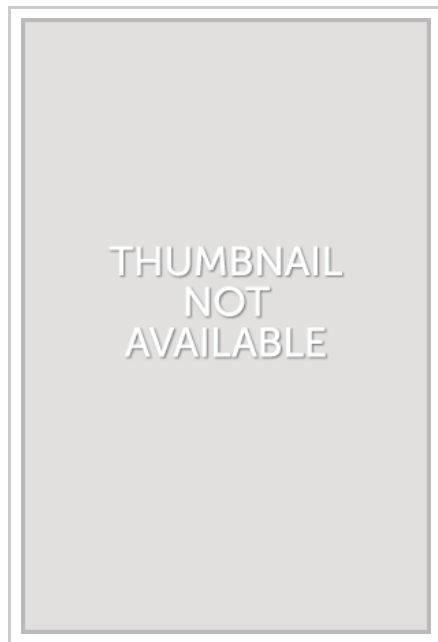




Academic Vocabulary in Middle and High School: Effective Practices Across the Disciplines (Paperback)
